What are Tables 7a, 7b and 7c for?

The Health tables record students:

- on certain pre-registration nursing, midwifery and allied health courses
- that started their course in 2016-17, 2017-18 or 2018-19

These students will already be recorded on Tables 1-3.

We collect information on these students to inform the transfer of funding responsibility from the Department of Health and for planning.



The transfer of funding responsibility

Funding responsibility for courses leading, on successful completion, to first registration as a professional in nursing, midwifery and certain allied health professions transferred from the Department of Health and Social Care to HEFCE and now the OfS.



The transfer of responsibility has been done in phases for different professions and levels of study:

- Phase 1, 2017-18: undergraduate other than dental hygiene and dental therapy
- Phase 2, 2018-19: dental hygiene and dental therapy, and postgraduate courses

We have been collecting information in advance of these transfers to calculate funding.

Changes from HESES17

- Next phase of transfer of funding responsibility to include undergraduate dental hygiene and dental therapy, and postgraduate pre-registration courses taking effect from 2018-19
- Now collecting information for students that started courses in 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19

Who is recorded on Table 7a, 7b and 7c?

- Home & EU students
- > Studying **specific pre-registration** courses
- > Who started their course in 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19.

These courses need to be approved by specific regulatory bodies:


- The Nursing and Midwifery Council
- The Health and Care Professions Council
- The General Dental Council

Further detail on these professions and courses is in Annex L of the HESES guidance.

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Starter vs New entrant

- 'Starter' in tables 7a, 7b and 7c does not have the same definition as 'New entrant' for Tables 5 and 6
- Generally speaking a 'Starter' is a student starting study for the first time on a relevant pre-registration course in 2016-17, 2017-18 or 2018-19.
- Due to the phased transfer of funding responsibility, 'starters in 2016-17' are not required on Tables 7a, 7b and 7c for dental hygiene/therapy and postgraduate courses



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Fundability status

Applies to Home and EU students

Varies by:

- Level of study (undergraduate or postgraduate)
- Profession of pre-registration course
- Year student was a starter (2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19)

All students recorded in Tables 7a, 7b and 7c will also already be recorded in Tables 1, 2 and 3.

- 1. Identify students that are:
- on the relevant courses and
- in the relevant 'Starter in' population

2. Record student years of instance using the same definitions (mode, level, etc) and columns as in Tables 1, 2 and 3.

We expect very few (if any):

- · students on sandwich years out
- · students on 'long' years of instance
