

DfE regulation: criteria and conditions of specific course designation imposed by the Secretary of State.

- *The DfE will make decisions about a provider's specific course designation. It will designate courses for 2018-19, and will monitor compliance with the criteria and conditions of designation during 2018-19, including by carrying out an annual monitoring exercise*
- *If the DfE decides to remove specific course designation or to impose any other sanction, during this period, this will not necessarily mean that the OfS will apply one of its own sanctions*



Students claiming student support and continuing study beyond 31 July 2019 may be able to complete their course if the provider satisfies requirements for 'teach out' arrangements. Communication with such providers will take place separately, including to set out the requirements and monitoring arrangements that would apply.
