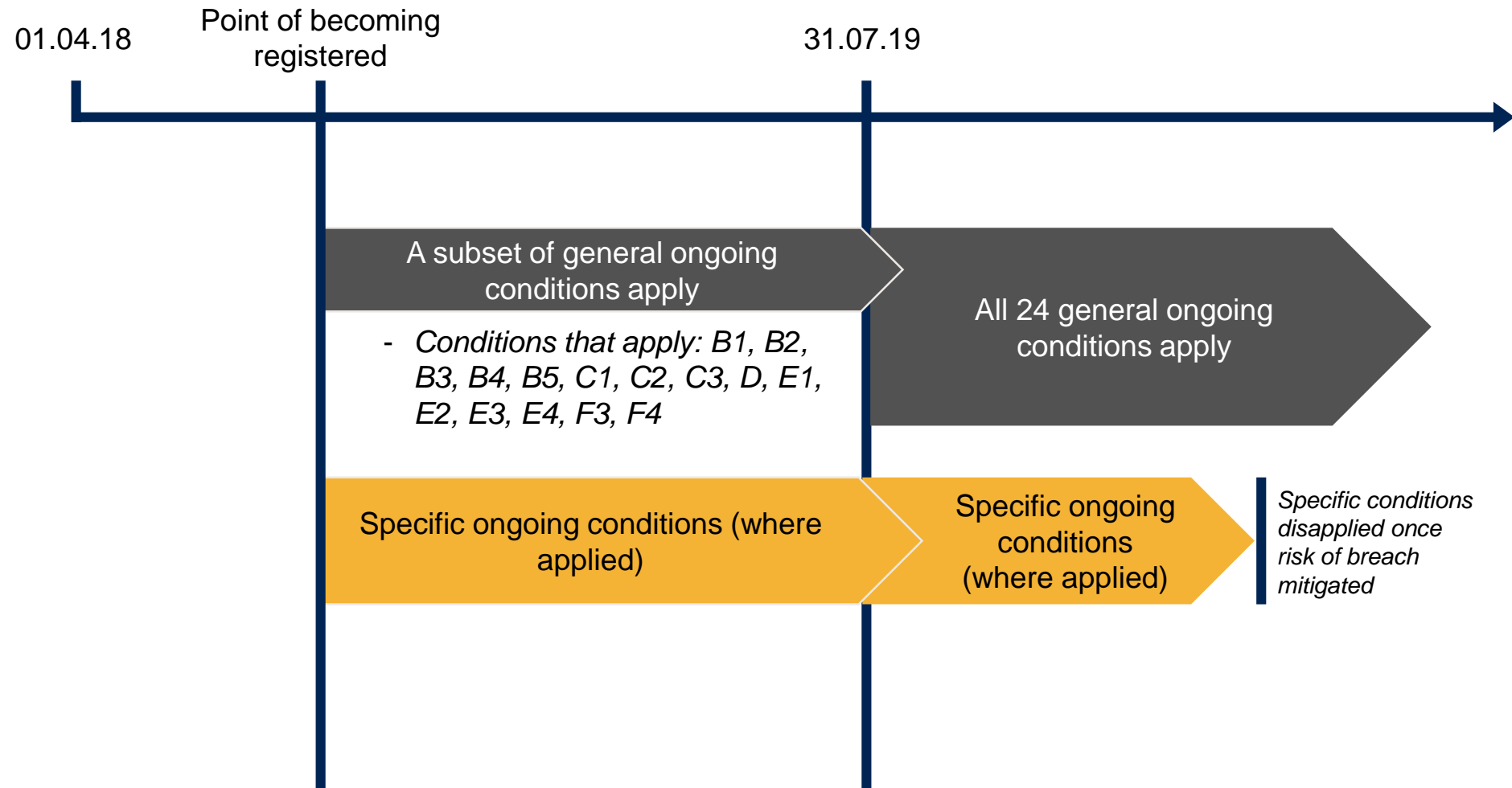


# As a...

- provider that has successfully registered with the OfS
- provider that was not designated for public funding under section 129 of the Education Reform Act 1988 immediately before its registration.
- provider that did not provide any course that was designated for student support under the Education (Student Support) Regulations 2011 immediately before its registration

# Providers that do not register

- **From August 2019, unregistered providers will not be able to:**
  - Receive OfS or Research England funding
  - Be eligible to retain or apply for a tier 4 licence
  - Apply for degree awarding powers or to use 'university' in their title
  - Access student funding through the Student Loans Company
- **And they may not (subject to the OfS taking revocation action) be able to:**
  - Use 'university' in their title
  - Possess degree awarding powers
