

How to count years of engagement



Some background...

- In the 2022-23 the Data Futures specification was released for providers returning data to the designated data body (DDB).
- The Student record uses 'engagements', whereas the Individualised Learner Record (ILR) uses 'instances'.
- For HESES purposes, we have used the language of 'engagements' and 'years of engagement' to create common terms.
- We are counting years of engagement for all providers, but how providers **determine** years of engagement will differ depending which data return is completed.
- In both cases, an 'engagement' is a student's commitment to an educational aim (the award of a qualification or credit or the completion of an apprenticeship) and its realisation over time.



What is an 'engagement'?

- Definition
 - An engagement is a student's commitment to an educational aim (qualification or credit) and its realisation over time
- Further education and sixth form colleges and academies (FECs)
 - Defined with reference to the anniversary of the student's start date (the same as year of instance)
 - Same as used in the Individualised Learner Record (ILR) for the ESFA
- Other providers
 - DDB Student record now using the Data Futures specification
 - Years of engagement based on the latest Student Course Session that starts in the 2023-24 academic year: for most students, likely to broadly align with year of instance




Counting student activity (Annex C1) – further education and sixth form colleges and academies

- For a student studying on a course that meets our definition of recognised higher education:
 - the first year of engagement begins when students start studying towards the qualification
 - the second and subsequent years of engagement start on or near the anniversary of this date (to allow for minor variations in term dates).
- For each year, student activity is counted if:
 - a fee is charged
 - they are not writing up a thesis or similar piece of work for the whole year
 - they have not withdrawn within two weeks of starting the engagement.



Counting student activity: which HESES?

• The academic year that a year of engagement **starts** in determines which HESES survey it's counted in




Counting student activity (Annex C2) – All other providers

- We are still counting years of engagement
- For a student studying on a course that meets our definition of recognised higher education:
 - the latest student course session which starts, or is predicted to start, in the 2023-24 academic year
 - subsequent years of engagement will be based on the SCS start date for the relevant years.
- For each year, student activity is counted if:
 - a fee is charged
 - they are not writing up a thesis or similar piece of work for the whole year
 - they have not withdrawn within two weeks of starting the engagement.



Counting student activity: which SCS?

• Only 1 student course session should be counted per engagement.



Counting student activity: Column 1 or 2?

- Years of engagement are recorded in either Column 1 or Column 2 on the relevant table this reflects whether the year starts **before** or **after** the HESES census date.
- If a student has withdrawn from their year of engagement on or before the census date, they should **not** be returned.



Standard and non-standard years

Standard year in column 1

- All activity contained within one academic year (1 August 31 July)
- Count at the start of each year of engagement.





- Included as a forecast year in column 2 at the start of each year of engagement: avoid double-counting.





Can students change column?

- Generally, students will stay in the same column they started HESES in.
- For those using student course sessions, changing column is possible in a few situations.

- You must use the specific **learning aim reference** for each course. There are limits on how many times you can enter the same learning aim.
- **Price groups** for each course are defined by the learning aim.
- A course can be split between price groups if so, you will have to enter the percentage for each price group:
 - enter figures that reflect the split between subjects over the course as a whole.
- Level and length are automatically completed but you can overwrite these if necessary.



What is the Courses table for?

- The Courses table is only visible in workbooks of further education and sixth form colleges and academies.
- It's only used to record years of engagement starting on or before the census date.
- Data entered on the courses table automatically populates Column 1 on Tables 1, 2, 3 and 5.
- Column 2 years of engagement will still have to be entered manually on the relevant tables.
- Data is entered at a course level, using learning aim references.
- We take a snapshot of the data in the Education and Skills Funding Agency's Learning Aim database. Using the learning aim reference, this data is used to automatically show:
 - course title price group(s)
 - level length.

- There are separate columns for each mode: full-time, sandwich year out and part-time
- Sub-columns separate out: fee status, fundability status and domicile
- Column for notes on temporary learning aims
- Only enter years of engagement starting before or on the census date (1 November):
 - those starting after that are entered manually in Column 2 of the appropriate table.

Office for **Ofs** Students

When two courses are part of one engagement

- When a student progress directly from one course to another at the same broad level (e.g. undergraduate or postgraduate taught), we would consider this to be a single engagement for HESES purposes.
- Examples:
 - A student completes a foundation degree then progresses straight away to a top-up year for a BSc.
 - A student completes an HNC, then progresses to top this up to an HND.
- If the top-up element overlaps with the year of engagement of the lower-level aim:
 - the Courses table cannot account for this
 - enter students against the higher learning aim.



When is a year of engagement part-time?

• A year of engagement should be recorded as part-time if it **does not** meet the requirements to be recorded as full-time or sandwich year out:

Full-time:


- The student is normally required to attend the provider, or elsewhere, for periods amounting to at least 24 weeks within the year of engagement.
- The student must average 21 hours of study per week.
- Full-time fees are chargeable.
- Further information can be found in the guidance or on defining a year as fulltime or a sandwich year out is available in the guidance and previous webinar.


What are tables 6a and 6c for?



- Record students on certain courses that lead, on successful completion, to first registration as a professional in nursing, midwifery and certain allied health professions
- Tables 6a and 6c are mutually exclusive
- These students will already have been recorded on table 1 or 3
- Tables 6a and 6c break these numbers down by:
 - profession
 - fundability status
 - starters in 2023-24.



Who is recorded on Tables 6a and 6c?



- Home fee students
- Studying specific pre-registration courses. Not all healthcare courses are recorded here.

These courses need to be approved by specific regulatory bodies:

- The Nursing and Midwifery Council
- The Health and Care Professions Council
- The General Dental Council.

Further detail on these professions and courses is in **Annex J of the HESES guidance**.

Starter versus new entrant

- 'Starter' in tables 6a and 6c does not have the same definition as 'New entrant' for Table 5
- A 'starter' is a student starting study for the first time on a relevant pre-registration course in a specific year
- For HESES23, you need to separately identify students who are starters in 2023-24





- An HTQ has to be approved by the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education (IfATE).
- A qualification may meet the requirements to be an HTQ without being approved this means it is **not** an HTQ.


